The Internet can be dangerous. I am making this agreement in order to have permission to have the privilege of using the Internet.

If I want to download any games, music, movies, or programs, I will ask for permission. Obtaining these things without paying is stealing.

I will never tell anyone online that I am home alone.

I won't give out my last name, or telephone number or my home address, the name of my school, where my parents work or their telephone numbers. I will never give out my friends' screen names, names, addresses and telephone numbers.

When I use instant messaging, e-mail, chat rooms, or Web sites where people put information about themselves, I will never send or post a picture of my family or me.

If I set up a blog or an online profile, I will tell my parents and let them read it.

I will not meet anyone that I have talked to online without letting my parents know.

My parents and I will decide when I am allowed to use the computer and the Internet. I will only visit places that they say I can.

I will give my passwords to my parents if they ask for them. I will not give anyone my passwords or my family's passwords. This includes friends and other relatives.

I will not enter contests or try to win free things on line. I will not buy things on the Internet without my parents' permission. If I get a message that says I won something, I will ignore or delete it. I will ignore, delete or show my parents if I get an e-mail asking for passwords or other private information.

I will not open or look at any of my parents' files. I will not change settings of the computer or install any new software without my parents' permission.

If anyone bothers or bullies me online does, I will tell my parents. I will never use cuss words, say bad things about others, or send hate emails, chat rooms, instant messages, or on blog sites. I will tell my parents if someone does that to me.

I will not use "secret" or "code" words online. I do not have total privacy on line. I give my parents permission to see where I have gone on the Internet. They are allowed to read any e-mail and text messages I have sent and received, or read what I post on any chat room. My parents have permission to install programs that track what I do on the computer or limit where I go online and I promise not to turn those programs off.
